



## MANAGEMENT

**HIKANE II** is a medium-maturing, forage sorghum hybrid with high yield potential. It adapts well to most growing conditions of the Great Plains and can be used for hay, grazing or silage. It has sweet stalks and it can tolerate drought stress very well. This hybrid should be cut in the soft-dough stage (110-120 days after emergence) for the highest tonnage and best quality silage. HIKANE II is 100% LDP approved!
